PlumFresh Member Agreement

Plum Granny Farm is offering *PlumFresh* as a membership subscription program for a weekly bag of our fresh fruits and vegetables. The program is designed for flexibility for the members – the bag is fully customizable, you can let us know if you need to skip a week, and payment can be made in advance or on a weekly basis. We have two share sizes: Regular (\$38 for a weekly bag) and Small (\$25 for a weekly bag). Delivery is available for \$6 per week.

It is important to understand that as a *PlumFresh* member, you are not just purchasing produce; your commitment supports our farm. You are forging a partnership with the farm. It is not simply a transactional relationship. By regularly getting your bag, you help us better plan and manage our growing and harvesting. Partnering with us helps sustain a local farm with a commitment to Organic, responsibly produced and quality food. It also allows us to provide good jobs and support our local community.

By signing up for *PlumFresh* and submitting a deposit, you acknowledge that you agree to the following terms of Membership:

- 1) You are joining *PlumFresh* for the 2022 Season which runs from May until November. You can cancel your weekly bag in advance if you are out of town, etc. through your online Farmigo account.
- 2) You may cancel your membership at any time but if you cancel prior to the first three bags, you will forfeit your deposit.
- 3) You will manage your *PlumFresh* transactions (bag changes, payment, delivery holds, etc.) through your online Farmigo account.
- 4) You will pre-pay or pay upon pick-up or delivery of the bag.
- 5) You will pick up your bag at the location (or delivery option) that you set at sign-up. If you do not cancel a bag by the cut-off time and do not pick up your bag, you will be charged, and the bag will be donated.
