Busy week around the farm! We've been taking advantage of the dry days to get things done -- although we definitely had a wet Wednesday. But we made some hay while the sun shone.

A BIG check mark came when Ray and Alex set posts for the greenhouse expansion. This has been on our to-do lists for a year now -- and even though it didn't get completed, progress was made! The post holes are three feet deep -- they have to be well-anchored in order to support such a large structure. And because the holes are SO deep, they have been a source of constant worry to us -- we don't want anyone to fall into one! Thankfully, we have been lucky (except Ray did go in one this past weekend as we were covering plants -- but he was very lucky and not injured!).





Getting that first post in is very tricky -- lots of math involved! It's got to be straight and plumb and squared up just right -- it was a Plumb Granny Perfect job for Ray and Alex!

And we got the posts in just in time -- before all the rain! We got nearly two inches of rain Wednesday.
