still have several more things to do in order to complete the project, the "box" is complete. Take a look....







Did you know that tomorrow is <u>World Migratory Bird Day</u>? This event is celebrated in the US and Canada on the 2nd Saturday in May as the migratory birds are returning to their nesting sites. It is celebrated in southern regions (Mexico, Central and South America) in October as birds return to their winter homes.

This year's campaign theme is <u>"Water: Sustaining Bird Life"</u>, which focuses on the importance of water to all birds. This becomes increasingly important as water sources become more threatened by pollution (conventional agriculture plays a huge role in this) as well as climate change. As the aquatic ecosystems become more endangered, so are the migratory birds that depend on them.
