This week's farm flower is the amazing Elephant Garlic Flower. We like to call them "Fireworks on a Stick"! This market favorite is the flowering scape of Elephant Garlic. They look like pom-poms on a stick and have a faint garlicky smell.

A cool thing about these flowers is that they are not only lovely to look at, but they are tasty as well. The florets that comprise the pom-pom add a pop of subtle garlic flavor to eggs, potatoes, salads and many more dishes. How many flowers can you have on your table for an edible arrangement?

Another neat thing about these is that they make a wonderful everlasting flower. They dry beautifully and look great in arrangements for years! We've got some in a vase that are probably 5 years old!

And don't forget, Elephant Garlic is not a true garlic but rather it is a bulbing

leek. Since it is one of the mildest of our garlic lineup, many folks find they can tolerate this allium better than spicier bulbs.

And just to give you the full picture of what the Elephant bulb looks like, check out a few that were just harvested -- whoa! We added a quarter to give a sense of scale.
